

# ONE SHOW AT A TIME

# In The Midnight Hour ...

February 10, 2010, Barton Hall at Cornell University for Further. I was standing in the gym, bobbing around with all the other excited heads in eager anticipation of what was to take place in the coming moments. Suddenly, the band appeared! Bob in his signature judo shorts, Phil standing and towering over everyone. Jeff and john standing idly by awaiting instructions from their leader and then Joe tapping on the drums in anticipation of letting loose as only Joe can. That's when I heard the distinctive clicking of Bobs strings as he tapped off the timing of the opening song and it was at that moment that the chills shot through my body and the hair on my arms stood up on end and I knew that the rush of being in the presence of the reincarnation of my favorite band would live on forever!!

Why you might ask? Because I was attending my first sober show and I was more excited and lit up than I had ever been before. I was a Wharfrat!!!

No more chasing the best this or the best that out in the lot. I found the greatest thing that coming to these shows had to offer besides the music, I had found a new way of life, a new way to enjoy the shows!! Sober!! It was a mir-

Instead of my head flopping around and stumbling uncontrollably I was twirling and dancing my head off in a way I never had before, the music was not only reaching my ears but it was reaching my soul and I could hear the band pour everything they had into that opening song, "in the midnight Hour" my pulse raced, my heart Beat excitedly. And that was only the opening

There was still a whole set in front of me and then the Wharfrat meeting where I got to meet other heads just like me and I felt at home.

Welcomed and at home in a group of like-minded people, we shared and talked and hugged and said a prayer and it was more magical than any chemical could produce!! I was truly happy and in awe of the whole mystical miracle known as the Wharfrats!!

Fast forward, I celebrated 12 years of continuous sobriety on 1/27/2019. My 12-year coin was presented to me by everyone's favorite hippie guru, Murph Shea. In turn I had the privilege of presenting Murph with his 26-year medallion. I live a life beyond my wildest dreams and continue to enjoy every show the same as the first, SOBER and HAPPY!!! - Don G.

# We Made It Through a Pandemic! ...

~~~~~~~~~~~~~~

Music is my higher power now. Actually, it always was, I was just too high to know most of the time.

Hi, I'm Katherine P. and I am a Wharf Rat. I miss that "HI KATHERINE" so much it almost brings tears to my eyes thinking about it.

In this year of 2021 I have 7 years clean. I got clean at 44. I have 30 years of using anything that will make me feel different.

In the beginning, I was hanging out with friends going to concerts in Houston, TX, watching live music, and laughing until my voice was gone. In the end, I was homeless, bruised, starving, cold, suffering from Stockholm syndrome, at a homeless battered women's shelter in Indianapolis, IN.

I started early. I used 3 or 4 substances before I was 15. I was sneaking into bars at 14 and 15. Before I graduated high school, I had used a needle. For years I did not have any major consequences. Sure, I lost jobs all the time, but growing up in Houston, the oil town, bad jobs where a dime a dozen.

I went to my first Grateful Dead show at the Summit in 1988. I had to almost be restrained because I wanted to run off with others and follow the dead. I didn't and I still regret it My using career involves losing almost everything I have a few times. Every time, I would get in an unhealthy relationship with a man who I hoped would save me. I went to rehab 5 times. I was at the clinic and on Mat off and on for 15 years. My life kept getting worse and my choices kept getting worse. I was not going to shows at all, because I could not even get the money together for gas to go. All my money and effort went into getting and using just one more. I was given Narcan 3 times for overdosing. The last time was on dog opiates that I stole from my work at the Veterinarian. I was married and divorced 3 times. Life was horrible but I did not know how to come out of this downward spiral.

In 2013 my mother had to come save me because I was getting evicted from a roach infested apartment in downtown Houston. She brought me to Indianapolis. I literally do not remember traveling to Indy at all.

This is where bad gets worse. I met a man at the methadone clinic in Indy that would kidnap me for 6 months. He suffered from schizophrenia and had just got out of prison. Of course I knew none of this. I just went off with him to get high and woke up being held at a dog kennel at gun point. It was bad. I did not bathe for months. He beat and raped me almost daily. I lost 70lbs. He was drugging my food. I truly understand how people come to sympathize with their kidnapper. One day he made the mistake of leaving his phone unattended. I called 911 and they took me to a homeless battered women's shelter where I was diagnosed with Stockholm syndrome.

In my heart I believe that my higher power said "Girl, I have put you in 5 rehabs, if this doesn't get you clean, I do not know what will".

While I was at the shelter I realized I had an opportunity I had not had in 15 years. I was off all the medications I was abusing and the methadone. I took my last dollar and went to a

I did not feel like I fit in most of the meeting in Indy. Here I was a street savvy big city girl and the meetings I went to people did not seem to understand me or me them.

I had a few people tell me I should go to a meeting in Indy called Rats. I thought that was

but I went. I remember finally exhaling as I saw people in tie-dye shirts. I know I said "OH Thank God, finally some freaks" aloud. That dusty old basement became my homegroup. The meeting "Rats NA drain ditch" introduced me to the Wharf Rats. Finally I could go see

live music again.

I have never felt more love! I am fully involved with the Wharf Rats.

I moved to Sarasota Florida and started a Wharf Rats meeting. I will set up my table at any show I can go to if I am allowed. Wharf Rats gave me back dancing and music, but also gives me a purpose. The purpose is to give traction in an otherwise slippery environment. Where a different 12 step program saved my life, Wharf Rats gave me back my passion.

I love all the Wharf Rats I still have never felt more loved. Thank you for everything. In my opinion the Wharf Rats meeting and the people are the most loving people in the world. I cannot wait to hold that yellow balloon and say "Hi I'm Katherine and I am a Wharf Rat". Ya'll we made it through a pandemic. Now, lets dance! - Katherine P.
